**District 1 City Council Report – Jerad Ferguson**

Upcoming events:

1. 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Senior Walk
    - Valleyfair on April 5<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am: free breakfast + prize giveaway.
  2. Great American Litter Pickup
    - Rainbow Park on April 20<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am-12:00 pm.
  3. Lynhaven E-waste fundraiser
    - March 30<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am -3:00 pm.
- Budget process: proposed budget to be released in May.
    - 5 year forecast released in in March; \$5.5 million deficit, was anticipating \$29 million deficit.
    - Priorities: hire more police officers and no more service level deductions.
      - Homeless encampments, residential burglaries, increasing marijuana tax.
  - Community budget meeting on May 2<sup>nd</sup> at Mitty High School, 6 pm.
    - Hear about details on budget.
  - New vision 2020: urban villages; commercial + residential for Stevens Creek, Winchester and Santana Row/Valleyfair.
    - Engage people's interest. Meeting for Winchester pending.
    - Possibility: Tax for transportation purposes.

**Guest Speaker- R. Weger**

- Police department for 22 years; police security on Santana Row.
- 2012- 35 auto burglaries, 13 vehicle thefts, 11 petty thefts, and 9 burglaries.
- 2013- 5 residential burglaries.
- Biggest issues: auto burglaries, vehicle thefts and burglaries.
- #1 call for 2013: suspicious people in suspicious vehicles.
- Safety precaution: Police suggest when answering door ask "Who is it?" instead of not answering.
- Other safety precautions: Make it harder for burglars to get into the backyard (close and lock gates) and make it look like people are around (lights on).

- If ever in doubt, call 911.
- SJ emergency line: (408) 277-8911.
- San Jose Clean app: takes a picture of graffiti and sends it to the city; city fixes it within 24 hours.
- Traffic enforcement unit; purpose: reducing accidents.
