- Top 10 warning signs of Alzheimer's disease- www.alz.org/10signs
- Every 69 seconds, someone is diagnosed.
 - Leading cause of death in the US.
- No genetic link in Alzheimer's besides early Alzheimer's (between ages 30-50).
- Dementia = broadest term of Alzheimer's.
- Memory loss does not necessarily mean Alzheimer's disease or dementia.
- Walk to end Alzheimer's
 - Date and Time: October 20, check-in opens at 8:30am and walk starts at 10 am. 3 mile route - with 1 mile option.
 - Location: Arena Green, W Santa Clara St & N Autumn Downtown San Jose, CA.
 - 20% of Alzheimer's Association funds come from walks.
 - Money raised from walks goes to research for a cure.

- FREE smart phone app for iPhone and Android: First Aid by American Red Cross.
 - Instructions for first aid scenarios.
 - Informative videos and animations.
 - Steps to take during an emergency.
 - Safety and preparedness tips for range of conditions; earthquakes, hurricanes, tornados, etc.

- Alert program still in progress.
- County wide practice: to be determined.
