Paid membership of 68 residents. Bank balance \$6,363.01. 2016 CAP check has been deposited. Cost reduction being made by elimination of printing/distribution of monthly meeting notices. District 1 – David Gomez, from Councilman Chappie Jones office

- CVS at Westgate West will be relocating to new location at Quito/Saratoga Avenue
- Mobile home park protection ordinance will go before city council in February. Intended to “protect” all MH parks in San Jose
- Rent control of some type likely coming to San Jose
- Chappie looking into homeless population “fix”. San Jose estimates 6500 homeless. Examining a Fresno program using “tough shed” housing at industrial park for consideration of ideas, and “Pavarello House” which helps homeless obtain benefits, healthcare, employment, future low income apartment.
- Moorpark cleanup – 2nd portion, Cypress to San Thomas cleanup by Caltrans TBA, weather/priority dependent.

- No feasibility/opportunity for “pocket park” due to zone considered by Caltrans as not safe/secure from potential vehicle entering from freeway.
- Riddle Road, potholes: Photos emailed to David for follow up
- Cadillac/Williamsburg Landlord Association being sponsored by city of San Jose in order to engage, clean up, and personally protect landlords.
- SJPD area Captain in Mark Burcios. Best contact is Lt. Jason Da
- David Gomez related his personal experiences with gang retribution.
